

Elgin School Food Service General Information

School Year 2024-2025

Elgin School participates in the Child Nutrition Program administered by the United States Department of Agriculture. Nutritious meals are served every school day. Menus are planned in accordance with the Dietary Guidelines for Americans. Meals provide 1/3 of the Recommended Daily Allowance (RDA) for calories, protein, vitamins A and C, calcium and iron at lunch and 1/4 of the RDA for these nutrients at breakfast.

Charge Policy:

Meals <u>must be paid for at the time of purchase</u> or in advance. See Charge Policy for more information.

2024-2025 Meal Prices

Breakfast: K-8 \$1.50 Adults \$2.00 × Lunch: K-8 \$2.75 Adults \$4.00 Milk \$.50 (milk must be paid for by free and/or reduced students if a whole meal is not received)

New Household Application:

A **NEW** free and reduced application is required by every household <u>each year</u>.

Verification:

Your eligibility may be verified by school officials at any time during the school year. You may be asked to send further information to prove that your child should be receiving free or reduced-price meals. Chocolate Milk:

Chocolate milk will only be available at breakfast and lunch on **Tuesdays and Thursdays.** Only **one** chocolate milk per day, if students wish to get a 2nd milk it must be white milk.
