Self-Insurance Device Policy

The Sonoita School District is self-insured and various provisions in this policy restrict coverage. Carefully read the policy to understand coverage and your family's rights and responsibilities. Please help us keep premium and deductible costs low by taking very good care of the device and protecting it in a padded laptop bag.

A. Costs (Non-refundable)

1. There is an annual premium of \$50. This premium is good for one school year.
2. Should there be a claim for insurance coverage, there is an additional deductible charge per claim depending on the damage.

B. Covered Equipment

1. The insurance provided applies to any device issued, purchased, or owned by Sonoita School District, whether it is the originally issued device, a loaner, or a replacement.
2. The deductible for the claim is the same, whether the machine is the original, a loaner, or a replacement device. For example, if your child has been issued a device loaner and breaks the device loaner, there will be a deductible due for the breakage of the device loaner.
3. There will not be an additional premium for the use of a device loaner
4. The data contained on the device is not covered. There is no provision for the time or cost needed to replicate any missing data.
5. Current condition of device will be noted and students will not be help responsible for existing wear and tear.

C. Exclusions

The school will not pay for loss or damage caused by or resulting from the following:

1. Intentional damage, dishonest, fraudulent, or criminal acts.
2. Any loss to accounts, valuable documents, music, videos, or assignments and/or their effects by being missing on grades, GPAs, etc. **Students are responsible for backing-up their own data.** An insurance claim will only cover material issues with the device, not loss opportunities or data.
3. Disappearance not accompanied by a policy report.

D. Claim Procedures

1. The Technology Department will examine the device to determine if there is a qualified insurance claim.
2. In case of theft or disappearance, you must file a policy report and submit a copy to the school.
3. If the claim qualifies for insurance, the guardian will be notified.

E. Declining Coverage

Guardians may decline to participate in this self-insurance program. In the event of damage or loss of the device, parents will be responsible for the actual cost of repair or replacement. Failure to pay for claims could limit your student's ability to participate in extracurricular activities.
